Traffic Rules

For your safety, it is important to know the rules of Japan.

28When walking

- ·Walk on sidewalks (paths for people to walk on).
- •On roads without sidewalks, walk on the right side of the road.
- •When crossing a street, cross where there is a traffic light or pedestrian crossing.



39When riding a bicycle

- ·Ride your bicycle on the left side of the roadway.
- •Do not ride a bicycle after drinking alcohol.
- •Do not ride a bicycle while using an umbrella or a cellular phone (smart phone).
- ·Wear a helmet when riding a bicycle.
- In Iga City (Mie Prefecture), all bicycle riders must submitt bicycle liability insurance.

30When driving a car or a motorcycle

- •A driver's license is required to drive a car or motorcycle. (The driving test can be taken in English, Portuguese, Chinese or Vietnamese.)
- •When driving a car or motorcycle, you must have a driver's license.
- •For the safety of both the driver and passengers, seat belts must be worn. Motorcycle riders should wear helmets.
- •Do not use a cellular phone (smart phone) when driving a car or motorcycle.
- ·You cannot drive if you have been drinking alcohol.
