

[Information] An "admission ticket" is required to enter the venue. Tickets can be obtained via the LINE app starting 14 days before the day you want to attend. Tickets can also be obtained at the venue on the same day. If there are many people, you may have to go on a different day.

【Who needs to file】

- ① People who run their own business, have real estate income, or sold land or a house
- ② People with two or more jobs and additional income.
- ③ People with dependents not included in year-end tax adjustment
- ④ People who want to claim medical expense deductions (money paid to the hospital)
- ⑤ People who bought a house with a mortgage loan (first-time filers) etc.



【What to bring for filing】

- ① My Number Card (If you do not have one, bring your notification card along with a driver's license, passport, or residence card)
- ② Smartphone (If you have one, please bring it. You will use your own smartphone and My Number Card to file.)
- ③ Tax returns or notice postcards from the tax office (if received)
- ④ Documents showing income for Reiwa 7 (such as withholding slips or income/expenditure statements)
- ⑤ Certificates required to claim deductions (receipts or certificates for National Health Insurance tax or long-term care insurance, deduction certificates for National Pension premiums, life insurance, earthquake insurance, medical expense deduction statement [prepared in advance], remittances, Housing loans, etc.)
- ⑥ Bank passbook (for those filing to receive income tax refunds; must be in your name)
- ⑦ Pen or other writing instruments

Please enroll in the National Pension System when you turn 20

さい こくみんねんきん はい
20歳になつたら国民年金に入つてください

"The National Pension" is a system that supports everyone's livelihood when they grow old or are unable to work due to illness. It includes the 'Old-age Pension' for when you get older, the 'Disability Pension' received if illness or an accident leaves you disabled, and the 'Survivors' Pension' received by the family left behind when a member passes away. People who turn 20 receive a notification from the Japan Pension Service asking them to enroll in the National Pension. Please complete the procedure. This notice does not reach those who are already working and enrolled in the Employees' Pension Insurance. Those coming from overseas just before turning 20 should complete the procedures to join the National Pension.

If you cannot pay the National Pension premiums and fall under the categories below, please apply:

- ◆ If you are a student and your income (salary) is below a certain amount, your premium payments can be deferred.
- ◆ If your family's income from last year was below a certain amount, your premiums may be fully or partially exempted.
- ◆ If you are under 50 years old, and both you and your spouse's income from last year was below a certain amount, your premium payments can be deferred.

Premiums can be discounted if paid in advance. If you wish to pay in advance via bank account transfer (automatic withdrawal), please apply.

Be careful of heat shock! ひとしょくくきつけ!

[What is Heat Shock]

When the temperature changes suddenly, blood pressure can rise or fall sharply. This can cause health problems such as fainting or heart conditions. Heat shock is often triggered by sudden temperature changes, such as moving from a warm room to a cold place or going outside after taking a bath.

[People Who Should Be Especially Careful]

Elderly people, people with high blood pressure, those with diabetes, or lipid disorders.

[Ways to Prevent Heat Shock]

«◆ Bath» Warm the bathroom before taking a bath. Keep the water temperature below 41°C.

Limit bath time to around 10 minutes. Avoid standing up quickly in the bath.

Do not bathe right after meals or after drinking alcohol.

«◆ Toilet» Warm the toilet seat or use a cover. When you go to the bathroom at night, make sure to keep yourself warm.

«◆ Prevent Dehydration (to avoid losing water in the body) » Drink water frequently even in cold weather.

«◆ Lifestyle Habits» Do light exercise. Eat a healthy diet. Maintain a regular daily routine.

How often should you check the food and water in your emergency supplies?

- A. Every month
- B. Every year
- C. Once every 10 years

January is the start of a new year—an ideal time to check and update your emergency supplies for peace of mind. Review the expiration dates on food and water (the period during which they remain safe and tasty to consume) and replace anything that's expired. Key supplies include non-perishable food, water, flashlights, batteries, and medicine. Be sure to check each year to ensure everything is still in good condition. Store your supplies near the entrance or bedroom so they're easy to grab in an emergency. Go through your supplies with your family to ensure everyone is prepared for any disaster.

Information お知らせ**“Prepare your water pipes for winter!” 水道管の冬の準備をしましょう！**

When the temperature drops below minus 4°C, the water inside the pipes may freeze.

To prevent the water pipes from freezing: Wrap the exposed water pipes and faucets with insulation material, old towels, or cloth. Then cover them with a plastic bag or similar material to keep the insulation from getting wet. Secure everything with tape. If the water pipes freeze and no water comes out:

Place a towel over the frozen pipes and slowly pour warm water over it. Be careful not to use hot water suddenly, as this can damage the pipes or faucets. If the water pipes or faucets are damaged:

Turn off the water shutoff valve, which is usually located near the meter. If you can't find the valve, wrap the broken area with cloth or tape and contact the designated repair company in your area to request repairs.

Note: If you will be away from home for a long period during cold weather, make sure to turn off the water shutoff valve.
